Today Agriculture Under Secretary for Rural Development Thomas Dorr presented Integrity Biofuels president and owner, Charles (Shorty) Whittington with a grant ceremonial check for \$500,000 as the recipient of the Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Program. The USDA Renewable Energy program funds grants and loan guarantees to agricultural producers and rural small businesses to provide them assistance as they install renewable energy systems and make energy efficiency improvements.

Integrity Biofuels Central Indiana's first Soy Biodiesel Production Facility plans to increase production at its Morristown Indiana site with the grant. Integrity is proud to produce Indiana's premium renewable fuel and is currently in the process of getting their facility's product labeled as BQ-9000 certified. BQ-9000 is the National Biodiesel Accreditation Program to improve and ensure quality biodiesel is being produced and distributed. The program is a unique combination of the ASTM standard for biodiesel, ASTM D 6751, and a quality systems program that includes storage, sampling, testing, blending, shipping, distribution, and fuel management practices.
