## **Integrity Biofuels Helps Pave the Partnership between Biodiesel and the Trucking Industry as they Team up with GasAmerica**

As drivers line up today at the GasAmerica Truck Stop in Knightstown just off exit 115 of Interstate 70 the Soy Biodiesel Pumps are flowing. The stop is now offering B10 Soy Biodiesel, a 10% soy biodiesel blend from Indiana's very own Integrity Biofuels located in Morristown. Truck drivers now have the long awaited option to use this renewable fuel as they travel Indiana's roadways.

A celebration of this latest retail site of cleaner burning, American-Made fuel is a sign that the trucking industry is becoming more aware of the benefits of biodiesel on their trucks, the environment and the freedom to use fuel that we produce right here in Indiana. Biodiesel made from soybeans can be used in any diesel engine with few or no modifications and is simple to use, biodegradable, nontoxic, and essentially free of sulfur and aromatics.

Charles "Shorty" Whittington the owner and president of Integrity Biofuels also holds the same titles for Grammer Industries a trucking company based out of Grammer, IN that uses renewable fuel. His trucks run on B-5 to B-20 depending on availability. Whittington's drivers have seen improved equipment performance and lubricity with the use of Biodiesel but still have a hard time finding the product. Whittington said "I think the trucking industry is still looking for the 'correct' and true story of biodiesel and the real benefits," he also stated "It is the job of the truck stops and fuel distributors to help educate truck drivers and promote the right thing for America."



Chris Novak, another speaker at today's celebration is the executive director of the Indiana Soybean Alliance and said, "The trucking industry is an important market for the future of soy biodiesel and GasAmerica's decision to carry soy biodiesel at its Knightstown Truck Stop is a great step forward". Novak also stated "Now that soy biodiesel is an option at a popular fueling station for truck drivers traveling I-70, we expect more stations to follow GasAmerica's example and add soy biodiesel to their pumps." Novak continued "This is truly a grand slam for

Hoosiers. Indiana-grown soybeans are being turned into Indiana-produced biodiesel that is then sold to an Indiana-owned fuel retailer who offers it to Hoosier drivers to put into their gas tanks”. He continued “We now just have to get the word out to diesel consumers, especially truck drivers that there is a quality alternative to traditional diesel fuel.”

Today’s program also featured comments from State Senator Beverly Gard (R-Greenfield) and Indiana State Department of Agriculture Director Andy Miller. As a long-time proponent of Indiana’s agriculture community, Senator Gard said she is happy to see biodiesel, as well as ethanol, becoming more available across the state. “Biofuels are important to Indiana’s economy because they provide yet another market for our farm products,” she said. “They also offer a viable alternative to foreign oil and help us take one step closer to energy independence.” The decision to offer biodiesel at its Knightstown location was an easy one, according to Jim Gentry of GasAmerica. With the addition of the Knightstown location, GasAmerica now offers biodiesel at eight sites in Indiana.
